2) Review and Selection of Citywide Holiday Streetpole Banner Designs

- The following Streetpole Banner Design options were presented for review by the Liaisons for the 2021 Holiday Season:

Concept C: Warm & Cozy – The most traditional of the set



Concept D: Surrealist - Most experimental, least conventional of the set



- The Liaisons recommended Concept A for the Streetpole Banner Design for the 2021 Holiday Season;
- Mayor Wunderlich requested the font utilized for the Concept A design for the "XOXO" text be modified to make the "O" look less like a "G"; the designers agreed to make the change for the presentation to the City Council.
- The Liaisons also agreed to recommend that the preferred Concept A be utilized for 3 holiday seasons (2021, 2022, and 2023).
